case is appealable whether to hear a case. Should the Student Judicial Board decide to hear a case, it must be placed on the docket immediately and the case must be heard within 14 days of the said offense.

Section 3. The appellant shall have the right to a public hearing, to be informed of the nature and the cause of the violation against him/her, to confront opposing witnesses, and to have witnesses in his/her own behalf. Notif cation of hearing dates shall occur within five (5) days upon receipt of the case application, and shall be made by the Chief Just ce of the Student Judicial Board. The appellant shall then have a minimum of seven (7) days in order to prepare his/her case. These dates are subject to change by the Chief Just if there are extenuating circumstances.

Section 4. The Student Judicial Board shall reach a decision on all cases by a majority vote of a quorum on the hearing date, or may postpone a ruling until the following hearing if the Board deems necessary. A quorum shall consist of five (5) of the seven (7) just ces. A quorum of the justices shall be required at a hearing in order for the hearing to occur.
